We invite you to continue reading the welcome booklet since you will find relevant information to make your stay more enjoyable.






INSTRUCTIONS

DIRECTION:

Directions from Québec:

- Take route 138 towards Baie-Saint-Paul.
- Exactly at kilometer 437

 (about 4.6 km after the entrance to the ski center-top), turn right onto a dirt road named « Chemin du Fief".
- At the end of the moose fence (flashing at night).

Directions from Baie-Saint-Paul:

- Take route 138 towards Quebec.
- Exactly at kilometer 437

 (about 4.7 km after the "rue Principale" of Petite-Rivière-Saint-François), turn left on a dirt road named "Chemin du Fief".
- At the beginning of the moose fence (displays flashing at night)





GENERAL GUIDELINES:

Check in: 5PM

Check out: 11AM

Pets are not allowed.

It is forbidden to smoke inside the Chalet.

Internet: Please choose the Wi-Fi signal: **Le Charlevoix**. The password is **lecharlevoix2024**.

Please note that sometimes the <u>cellular signal</u> is unstable in our area. However, we have high-speed internet at the Chalet.

Makeup removal should not be made with **towels** and these should not be used on the ground outside, otherwise you will be charged extra for laundering.

It is not necessary to wash the **bedding** or **towels** before leaving.

When you leave, make sure the <u>dirty dishes</u> are put in the dishwasher and make sure the dishwasher is turned on.

We also ask you to make sure that the <u>fireplace</u> or the <u>air</u> <u>conditioning</u> (depending on the season) are turned off.

We ask for your cooperation not to throw fat or grease into the kitchen sink.





FRONT DOOR:

- Upon arrival, enter your code as received with the instructions.
- If the code lock does not work (dead batteries), a spare key is located in the box to the right of the front door. The code to open the box is the same as the code for the lock.
- When you leave, press the padlock icon. Check that the door is locked. If you used the spare key, please put it back in the box and close it. Mix up the numbers of the combination.

ALARM SYSTEM:

- Upon arrival, enter your code twice to disable the alarm system.
- When you leave, make sure all the doors are securely closed, enter the code to activate the alarm system.
- Once the system is armed, you have two minutes to leave.

FIREPLACE:

- Open the door with the metal lever hooked behind the fireplace to your right.
- Move the air intake handle at the bottom of the fireplace to the right when you light the stove.
- When the fireplace is light, adjust the combustion with the air inlet handle.
- The chalet is equipped with a carbon monoxide detector.





WATER USAGE:

- Our cottage is equipped with a septic tank and an artesian well, so we thank you for respecting these rules :

Toilet:

 We must throw only the toilet paper provided. Tissues and tampons are prohibited. Please throw them in the basket.

For showers:

 Since our water comes from an artesian well, we ask you to space the use of showers.

AIR CONDITIONER:

To maximize the efficiency of the air conditioner, make sure all windows are closed. A temperature of 24 degrees Celsius is recommended.

- 1. With the help of the remote, press on the button MODE to select the mode COLD or VENTILATION.
- 2. Use the buttons \wedge / V to set the desired temperature.
- 3. Use the button FAN/VENTILATION to select the speed of the fan.
- 4. Use the ON/OFF button to start the air conditioner.





SOUND SYSTEM:

To use the sound system, you must use Bluetooth on your Bluetooth enabled device.

- 1- Open the device by pressing the on key.
- 2- Press the Bluetooth pairing button on the sound system for 3 seconds.
- 3- Activate the Bluetooth function on your device (eg cell phone).
- 4- Select the **SoundCore 2** device from the list.
- 5- It is only possible to use the sound system for one user at a time via Bluetooth.
- 6- Please leave the unit in its place.

POOL TABLE:

- Thank you for taking care of the pool table by not putting food or drink on the carpet and the edge.
- Since the table has been carefully leveled, we ask you not to move it.

WASHER AND DRYER:

- 1- Open the water supply valve (blue and red behind the washer).
- 2- Always close these after use.
- 3- Do not use these appliances when you are away from the cottage.





TELEVISION:

- The TV is connected to Wi-Fi. You have access to basic apps like Netflix (subscription required), Youtube, etc. You can browse the web. Use HDMI 1 source and the HiSense remote control..
- For TV channels, use the Helix remote control. Please refer to the following guide if necessary:

ESPRESSO MACHINE AND COFFEE GRINDER:

- 1- Fill the water tank located at the back of the machine with cold water.
- 2- Turn on the machine using the top switch.
- 3- Turn on the coffee grinder.
- 4- Insert the filter into the portafilter. Using the portafilter, press the coffee grinder button and grind the desired amount of coffee. For a finer grind, turn the dial clockwise (to the right). For a coarser grind, turn it counterclockwise (to the left).
- 5- Tamp the ground coffee into the portafilter using the coffee tamper.
- 6- Insert the portafilter into the machine. When the machine is ready (blue light), turn on the bottom switch until you obtain the desired amount, then turn it off.
- 7- Milk frothing:
 - a. Turn on the middle switch.
 - b. When the machine is ready (blue light), turn the dial on the side of the machine counterclockwise (to the left) to generate steam. Froth the milk. Turn the dial clockwise (to the right) when finished.





8- Purge the machine by running the water for a few seconds (after removing the portafilter) and releasing a little steam.

FILTER COFFEE MACHINE:

1- Fill the Water Reservoir

Open the reservoir lid and pour in water, using the water level window indicator to measure the number of cups desired. NOTE: Do not exceed the 12-cup line. Doing so could cause carafe to overflow.

2- Add Beans

Remove the hopper lid. Make sure the hopper is in the LOCK position with arrows lined up, then add enough beans for the number of cups you intend to brew. We recommend keeping the hopper at least half full. But, be careful: maximum capacity is ½ lb. and overfilling the hopper may jam the grinder. For easy filling, the hopper container can be taken out by turning the hopper container release knob to the unlock position.

Note: Do not put any water in the unit once the hopper container has been removed. If water gets into the grinder motor, the motor may become damaged and may malfunction. Put hopper lid back in place.

3- Lock Hopper

If you have removed the hopper from the unit, be sure that the hopper container release knob is in the unlocked position and place the hopper container back in the unit. Turn the knob to locked position. This unit is equipped with a safety interlock system. The unit will not operate grinding function if the hopper container is not in place. If you try to turn on the unit for grinding with the hopper out of place, the unit will beep continuously until the missing part is installed.

4- Inserting the Coffee Filter

Press the Filter Basket Door Release Button to open door. Remove the filter basket cover.

• Basket-style paper filter: Be sure filter is fully opened and touching walls of basket. • Cuisinart commercial-style permanent filter: Position handle of our gold-tone filter toward front of coffeemaker so it does not obstruct water flow. Put filter basket cover in place, with arrows aligned, and push the filter basket door closed until you hear it snap shut. NOTE: The built-in safety interlock system will not allow unit to operate if filter or filter basket cover are not in place, or if the door is not properly closed. A continuous beep will sound until everything is in place.

5- Brewing To Brew Right Away

- a. Turn the Grind Control knob to select the number of cups you want to brew. The burr grinder will grind the correct amount of beans, and automatically adjust the coffee/ water ratio for low cup settings.
- b. Press the Strength Control button to select flavor intensity: MILD, MED or STRONG will show on the LCD display.
- c. Press On/Off button. Red LED will light up and brewing will begin.

6- After Brewing

When brew cycle is complete, five beeps will sound. Coffee will continue to stream from the filter for several seconds. Coffeemaker will automatically shut off after two hours, or at the programmed auto-shutoff time.





SPA (HOT TUB):

Upon your arrival, the spa water has been checked and is ready for use.

To maintain good water quality, it is recommended that a maximum of 6 people be in the spa at a time and that food and beverages not be consumed inside. Food or beverages in the spa water may render it unusable. If this occurs, a \$200 deposit will be deducted from your security deposit to drain the spa.

Using the spa:

- 1- Leave the support in place.
- 2- Tilt the first part of the cover onto the second.
- 3- Grasp the support with both hands and slowly move it backward.

To maintain good water quality, it is recommended to leave the jets running at all times during use. It is important not to leave the jet activation washers inside the spa closed for an extended period of time, otherwise the water quality will deteriorate and the spa will no longer be usable. Once you have finished using the spa, close the cover.

The spa is serviced twice a week. Therefore, there is no need to add any products yourself. If you encounter a problem with the spa or have any concerns about the water quality, please do not hesitate to contact Martyne or Johane (contact details on the front page).
